UPLIFT Updates

- The Office of Supportive Housing is moving back to our permanent location (150 Tasman Dr) on Monday, 8/7
 - Pass pickup will be unavailable starting 2pm this Friday 8/4 through Tuesday 8/8 as we get situated
 - Check your email inbox (or spam



folder) for emails from UPLIFT@hhs.sccgov.org for details

- 92% of Q1 stickers have been issued
- The pooled pass period began on 8/1
- We are currently fulfilling requests for the remaining Q1 passes on a first-come, first-served basis
- Reminder! Requesting a replacement pass for a client with a lost or stolen pass is a two-step process:
 - 1. Send an email to UPLIFT@hhs.sccgov.org explaining the reason for the replacement request
 - 2. Submit the request in HMIS by creating a Status Update Assessment
- Starting next quarter (Q2), OSH will again begin tracking pass request errors.
 - Staff with 3+ errors will have their HMIS UPLIFT access removed.
 Re-training will be required before access is restored.

Expected Changes

Beginning in the FY 2024 HMIS Data Standards, Rapid Re-Housing (RRH) projects can be classified in one of two subtypes

1. RRH: Services Only

2. RRH: Housing with or without services

The <u>Housing with or without services</u> subtype must be selected if the project receives any ongoing rental funds, even if not all project participants receive housing assistance funds from the RRH project

The <u>Services Only</u> subtype if the ongoing housing assistance for all program participants is provided by another funding source (e.g., Housing Choice Voucher, HUD VASH, other RRH project)

 If a RRH project has a 'Services Only' subtype, <u>no inventory records</u> should be created in Bed and Unit Inventory Information

2.02 Project Elements: Rapid Rehousing Updates

2022 Current Data Standards

Rapid Rehousing Program Type

TA/Agency Lead can set these programs up to provide housing and/or services related to a housing program

Supportive Services Only Program Type

TA/Agency leads can choose to make this program "Affiliated with a residential project" or "NOT Affiliated with a residential project"

2024 Data Standards

Rapid Rehousing Program Type

Agency lead can set programs up to provide housing and/or services related to a housing program

- Subtype: <u>Housing with or without</u>
 <u>services:</u> clients receive *any* ongoing rental funds for housing project
- → Subtype: <u>Services Only</u> No beds or units associated

Supportive Services Only Program Type

If affiliated with a residential project, the services must meet a set of criteria. For example, providing across many programs – or providing services only to a subset of clients in a residential project


