Recently Updated Housing Triage Tool

As of February 28, 2022, the VI-SPDAT has no longer been included in the Housing Triage Tool. The removal of the VI-SPDAT was a result of consistent feedback from our community about the invasive and traumatizing effect this tool has on households experiencing homelessness, as well as [data](#) indicating that the continued use of the VI-SPDAT for prioritization produces racially inequitable results.
