Additionally, HUD has shared a proposed timetable of changes for upcoming fiscal year 2024 Data Standard Changes. Check out the details!

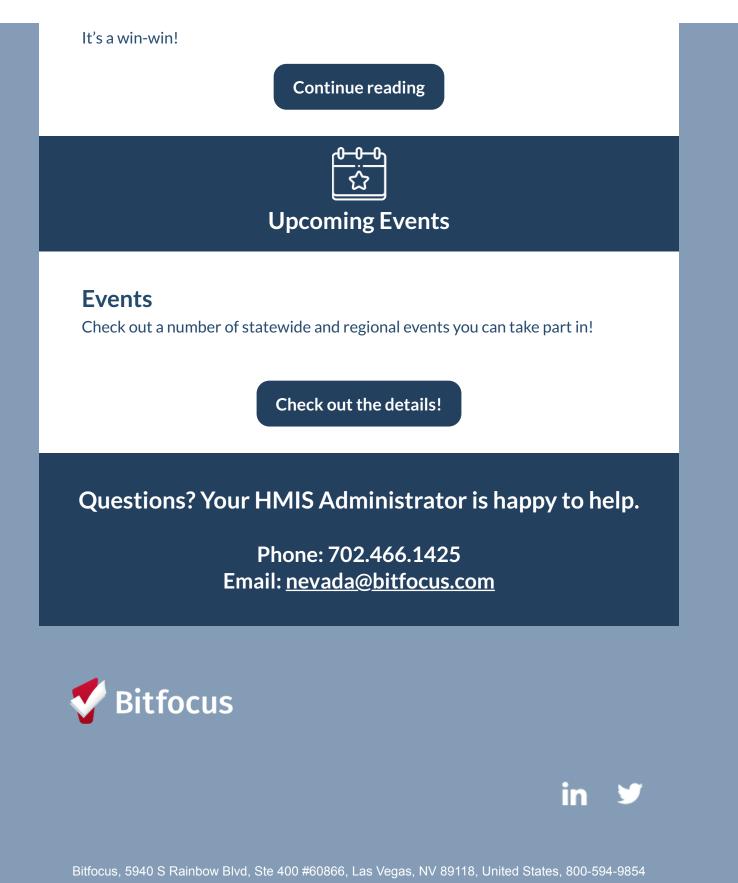

### Report Spotlight: [EXIT 101] Potential Exits

This month's report spotlight is the EXIT-101 Potential Exits report, which is found in the report library section of Clarity Human Services. The report determines if clients need to be manually removed from the program with the correct destination selected, avoiding whenever possible the destination responses of: client doesn't know, client refused, and data not collected. These simple steps will create clean data and help the overall system perform better.
