This year, Santa Cruz County's PIT Count will occur on January 26, 2023 (both unsheltered and sheltered counts.)

Unsheltered PIT Count:

WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING?

Volunteers are an integral part of the Point-in-Time Count effort; they help support a robust and accurate collection of data on our neighbors experiencing homelessness. Volunteers will work in teams to conduct a visual tally of persons experiencing homelessness across Santa Cruz County on **Thursday, January 26** ¹⁸

Volunteers will work in groups 5:00am to 10:00am, meeting their team members either at a central deployment center location or a convenient location before walking/driving their assigned routes and aiding with data collection. Volunteers are asked to bring their vehicles to use in the count if they are able.

Report Spotlight

Review Your Data for the Point-in-Time Count

The Santa Cruz sheltered Point-in-Time Count will occur on January 26, 2023. This means that you will need to make sure your shelter, transitional housing,


and/or permanent housing program has complete and up-to-date data for the night of January 26, 2023, and make sure it's entered accurately into the HMIS no later than February 2, 2023. To check your data, please run the following reports as soon as your January 26, 2023 enrollments, exits, and services are entered.

First Check Occupancy

Check your occupancy by running the **Housing Census Report** for one night: January 26, 2023. There are two Housing Census Reports. Both can be found in the Housing folder in the Report Library.

- For night-by-night shelters, use [HSNG-101] Housing Census [Service Based1
- For entry-exit programs of all types, use [HSNG-108] Housing Census [Program Based]

FAQ Page:

Have you visited the **FAQ page** before? This page includes answers to many general questions you may run into as you are entering client or program data

into Clarity. These questions are also searchable, so you can easily search by keyword to see if any of your general questions are answered here. Check it out!

The HMIS Standard Intake asks the question of race and ethnicity. What is the difference?	+
How does HUD define employment income?	+
Clients in my program are sometimes unwilling to provide identifying information. Can I just record "client refused" rather than asking?	+
What happens when a household remains working with the same program, but moves from one unit to another without any days of homelessness in between?	+
What happens when a household remains working with the same program, but temporarily experiences homelessness before moving into a new unit?	+
What happens when a household transfers programs, but remains in the same unit?	+
Is the move-in date the same as the "lease date"?	+
What happens if there appears to be an overlapping enrollment?	+
What happens if the household never moves into a unit?	+
