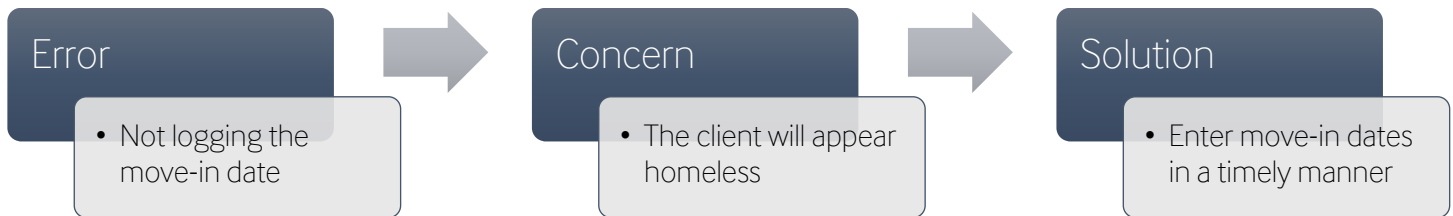


Permanent Housing Programs: Housing Move-in Date


The housing move-in date refers to the date a household will physically begin sleeping in their new permanent unit. This date is critical in differentiating between those who are housed within a permanent housing program and those who are still working toward moving into their new home. When reviewing client program details, please be on the lookout for these common errors:

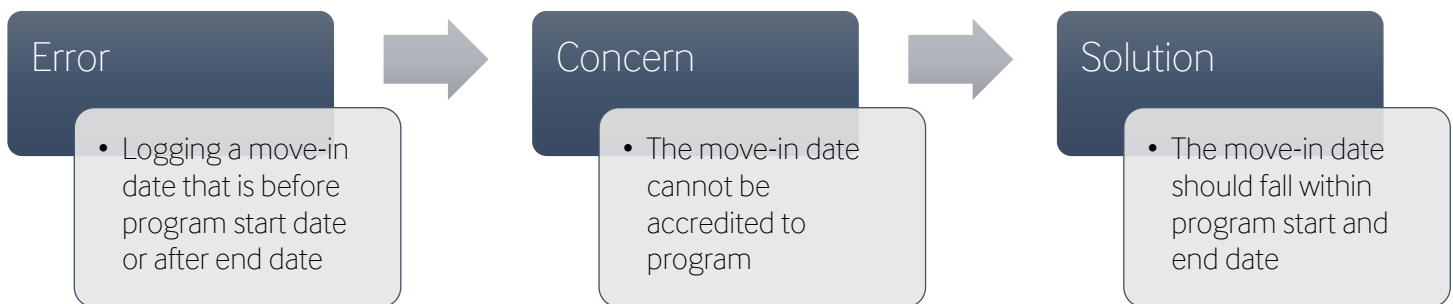

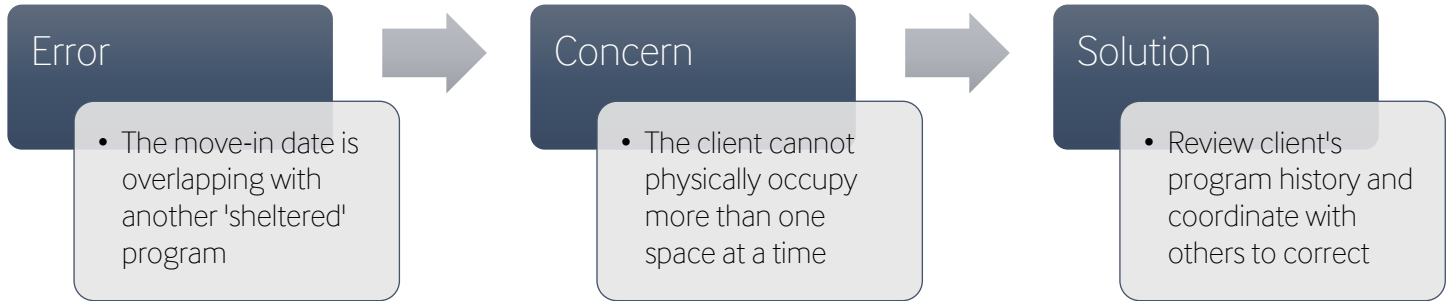

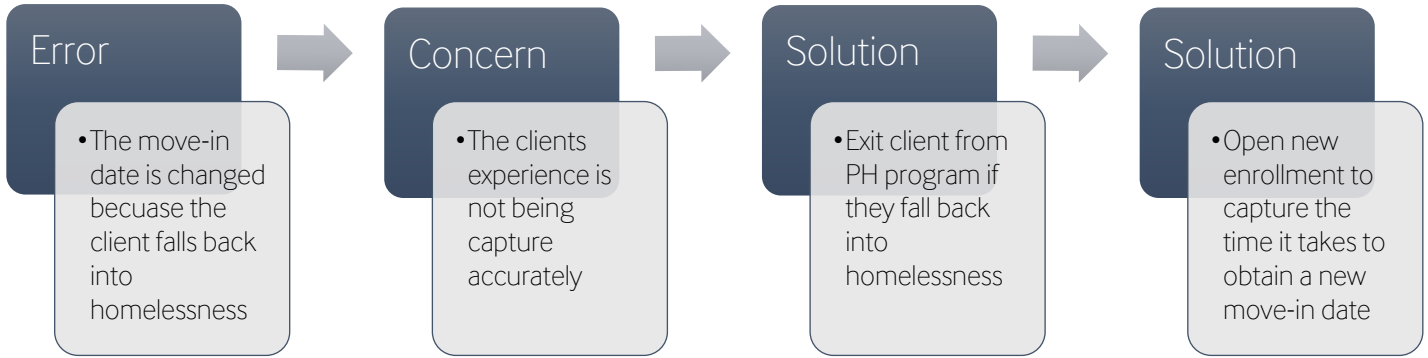

Commonly Asked Questions

Question

Answer

What happens when a household remains working with the same program, but moves from one unit to another without any days of homelessness in between?

It is not necessary to exit and reenroll them. The move-in date would still accurately reflect the day they entered permanent housing according to that enrollment record.

What happens when a household transfers programs, but remains in the same unit?

The enrollment and move-in date of the new program would be the day after the first program ends.

It is not necessary or appropriate to have the original housing move-in date reflected in the new program since the purpose of this data element is to distinguish between housed and homeless status within an enrollment.

Is the move-in date the same as the “lease date?”

HUD defines the move-in date as the date the household is physically sleeping in the unit; sometimes with corresponds with the lease date, but it doesn’t have to.

What happens if the household never moves into a unit?

Do not enter a move-in date and exit from the program to the accurate destination when appropriate.

What happens if there appears to be an overlapping enrollment?

Contact the program to verify/update their data.
