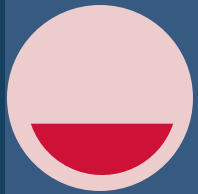

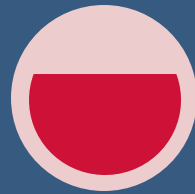

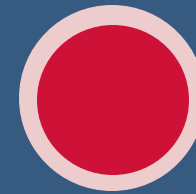

* Standard Screens and Templates will be updated by Bitfocus. Custom screens will require additional system admin action.

Report Library Release Timeline

Training, Live, and Migration Sites:

- > Updated federal reports (APR, CAPER, CSV Export, etc.) available October 1.
- > Old versions will be archived, no longer available after October 1.
 - > Applicable HUD project-level reports will be available longer for APR/CAPER submissions.
- > Updated supplemental and custom reports will follow.

- > 2024 XML delayed – once specs available, Bitfocus will implement (timeline TBD).
- > 2022 XML will be available until the 2024 XML is ready.
- > **Caution:** Using the 2022 XML after October 1 means the export **will not include** new or updated 2024 elements.

New service items added to existing projects.

Coordinated Entry Event Updates

Remove “Referral to Emergency Housing Voucher”

Referral event will be removed as of October 1.

Beginning October 1, communities with remaining EHV resources should enter these as “Referral to Other PH project/unit/resource opening”
