

How to Exit from the Marin Coordinated Entry Program

Definitions of HMIS Exit Terms

Destination	Where they go
Housing Assessment Disposition	Why they are being exited from the program and what CE's relationship is to them.

Exit Scenarios

When to exit a person from Coordinated Entry:

A person is exited from the Coordinated Entry Program under the following conditions:

- They get Permanent Housing via our resources (PSH, PH or RRH)
- They self-resolve by finding housing with friends or family
- Their whereabouts are unknown for longer than 90 days and our outreach teams and service providers indicate they no longer know where they are.

Note: if a person is in Shelter or Transitional Housing (e.g., Mill Street or Homeward Bound Family Center, Next Key) they are still homeless and are not to be exited from Coordinated Entry until they self-resolve or have a permanent solution.

When not to exit a person:

- A person is still homeless, in a shelter, or transitional housing
- A person has been active in HMIS with a service or engagement in the last 90 days, our outreach teams indicate the person is still in the County

How to Exit a Person from Coordinated Entry Program in Clarity

PSH Scenario	
Examples: 4 th street, Palm Court, Buckelew HUD, Vouchers (HHS, Mainsteam, VASH and S+C) , Carmel	
Project Exit Date	06/21/2019 
Destination	Permanent housing (other than RRH) for formerly homeless persons 
Housing Assessment Disposition	Referred to permanent supportive housing 
DISABLING CONDITIONS AND BARRIERS	

PH but Not S (Permanent Housing but not Permanent Supportive Housing)
(i.e., no disability requirement)

Examples: King Street, Oma Village

Project Exit Date	06/21/2019 
Destination	Permanent housing (other than RRH) for formerly homeless persons ▼
Housing Assessment Disposition	<u>Referred to another continuum project type</u> ▼

Scenario: RRH (Rapid Rehousing)

Examples: CalWorks, Any County RRH, e.g. Vinnies, Adopt A Family RRH or ESG

Project Exit Date	06/21/2019 
Destination	Rental by client, with RRH or equivalent subsidy ▼
Housing Assessment Disposition	<u>Referred to rapid re-housing</u> ▼

Scenario: Deceased

Project Exit Date	06/21/2019 
Destination	Deceased ▼
Housing Assessment Disposition	<u>Unable to refer/accept within continuum; ineligible for continuum projects</u> ▼

Scenario: Staying with Family and Friends

Note: default to “temporary tenure” unless the exiter says it is permanent. We go with the client’s definition.

Project Exit Date	02/04/2019 
Destination	Staying or living with family, permanent tenure 
Housing Assessment Disposition	Other/specify 
Specify Other Housing Assessment Disposition	Self resolved

Scenario: Out of County for extended period of time

Destination	Other 
Specify Other Exit Destination	Out of County
Housing Assessment Disposition	Other/specify 
Specify Other Housing Assessment Disposition	Inactive

Scenario: Whereabouts Unknown

Project Exit Date	04/01/2019 
Destination	No exit interview completed 
Housing Assessment Disposition	Other/specify 
Specify Other Housing Assessment Disposition	Whereabouts unknown

Long term Facility

Project Exit Date	02/06/2019 
Destination	Long-term care facility or nursing home 
Housing Assessment Disposition	<u>Unable to refer/accept within continuum; ineligible for continuum projects</u> 

Rental by Client with no Subsidy/non-homeless subsidy (e.g. Section 8 not through Coordinated Entry)

Project Exit Date	03/29/2019 
Destination	Rental by client, no ongoing housing subsidy 
Housing Assessment Disposition	Other/specify 
Specify Other Housing Assessment Disposition	Self-resolved
