2023 HIC/PIT

What is the HIC/PIT?

The Point-in-Time (PIT) Count is a count of sheltered and unsheltered people experiencing homelessness on a single night in January.

- HUD requires that Continuums of Care conduct an annual count of people experiencing homelessness who are sheltered in emergency shelter, transitional housing, and Safe Havens on a single night.
- Continuums of Care also must conduct a count of unsheltered people experiencing homelessness every other year.
- Each count is planned, coordinated, and carried out locally.

What is the HIC/PIT? (cont.)

The Housing Inventory Count (HIC) reports on shelter and housing programs (ES, TH, RRH, PSH), including non-participating HMIS programs (e.g. DV programs) and includes:

- Bed/unit capacity
- Federal funding source
- HMIS participation
- Location (geocode and address)
- Other project details
- Utilization rate based on clients in shelter/housing during one night in January (point-in-time count)

2023 HIC/PIT – Jan 26



- San Francisco will conduct the HIC/PIT Count on **January 26, 2023**
- All Shelter and Housing projects will need to report the actual number of clients served on the night of January 26. Information will be used to calculate Utilization Rates for each project.
 - PSH, RRH, and OPH (Other Permanent Housing) Projects will be based on clients housed
 - RRH bed/unit inventory will be based on housed clients on the night of the HIC/PIT

2023 HIC/PIT

- How can you prepare?
 - Run the [\[GNRL-106\] Program Roster](#) and review the list of active clients
 - Exit clients who are no longer in the project
 - Enroll missing clients
 - RRH and PSH projects - Fill out the Housing Move-In Date for your housed clients in the enrollment screen
 - Housing Move-In Date should always be on or after the Project Start Date (if the client was housed at entry, use the Project Start Date)
 - The deadline for any review and correction of program rosters for the night of the HIC/PIC is **February 10, 2023**

[GNRL-106] Program Roster Report

To run the [GNRL-106] Program Roster report:

1. Log into the **ONE System** and navigate to the **Report Library (Reports** under the **Launchpad** menu in the upper right corner)
2. Locate **[GNRL-106] Program Roster** under the **Program Based Reports** section and click Run
3. Choose the Program or Programs you wish to include in the report
4. Select the **Status** as “Active within Report Date Range”
5. For **HoHs only?** select “No”
6. Enter the start date (01/26/2023) and end date (01/27/2023) for the report to focus on the PIT reporting period
7. Click **Submit**
