2023 HIC/PIT Updates



2023 HIC/PIT Updates

- This year's **Housing Inventory Count (HIC) and** Point-in-Time (PIT) Count occurred on January 26, 2023
- Currently conducting data review and cleanup for shelter and housing program rosters and inventory
- Final submission deadline: **April 28, 2023**





2023 HIC/PIT: What can you do?

Proactive ways you can help ensure a successful HIC/PIT:

- Run the [GNRL-106] Program Roster for night of PIT count (01/26/2023-01/27/2023) and review the list of active clients
 - Exit clients who weren't in the project that night
 - Enroll missing clients
- Fill in the Housing Move-In Date for your housed clients in the enrollment screen for your PSH and RRH projects
 - PSH, RRH, and OPH (Other Permanent Housing) Projects will be based on clients housed
 - RRH bed/unit inventory will be based on housed clients on the night of the HIC/PIT
- Respond quickly to your HSH Program Manager when they reach out with any questions or requests for data cleanup





[GNRL-106] Program Roster Report

To run the [GNRL-106] Program Roster report for HIC/PIT data review:

- Log into the ONE System and navigate to the Report Library (Reports under the Launchpad menu in the upper right corner)
- Locate [GNRL-106] Program Roster under the Program Based Reports section and click Run
- 3. Choose the Program or Programs you wish to include in the report
- 4. Select the **Status** as "Active within Report Date Range"
- 5. For **HoHs only?** select "No"
- 6. Enter the start date (01/26/2023) and end date (01/27/2023) for the report to focus on the PIT reporting period
- 7. Click **Submit**



[HUDX-225] HMIS Data Quality

Demographic data pulled into the HIC/PIT report includes:

- Number of children, adults aged 18-24, adults over 24
- Race, Ethnicity, Gender, Chronic Homelessness
- Disability, i.e. Substance Abuse, Mental Illness, DV, HIV/AIDS
- Subpopulations i.e. Veterans, Parenting Youth, Unaccompanied Youth

[HUDX-225] HMIS Data Quality

- Reviews data quality across a variety of HMIS data elements
- Highlights errors in data quality, and gives opportunity to drill down by client and household
