

# Current Living Situation Assessment Training Document

## Description of the assessment

### What is the Current Living Situation Assessment?

The purpose of the Living Situation Assessment is to regularly document the current living situation of people experiencing homelessness and are connected to the following programs: *street outreach, night by night shelters, and services only*. Living situations are used to understand how many times a person is engaged while experiencing homelessness and can also be used to document homeless chronicity and risk of imminent homelessness.


### When to record the Current Living Assessment?

For Coordinated Entry projects, record a Current Living Situation anytime any of the following occurs:

1. At project start date (at time of enrollment)
2. A Coordinated Entry Assessment or Coordinated Entry Event Service is recorded; or
3. The client's living situation changes

## How to record the Current Living Situation Assessment

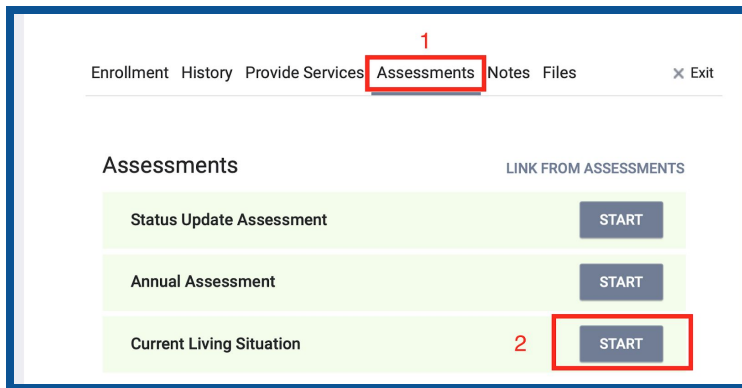
**Step 1:** Search for the client and open the program enrollment.



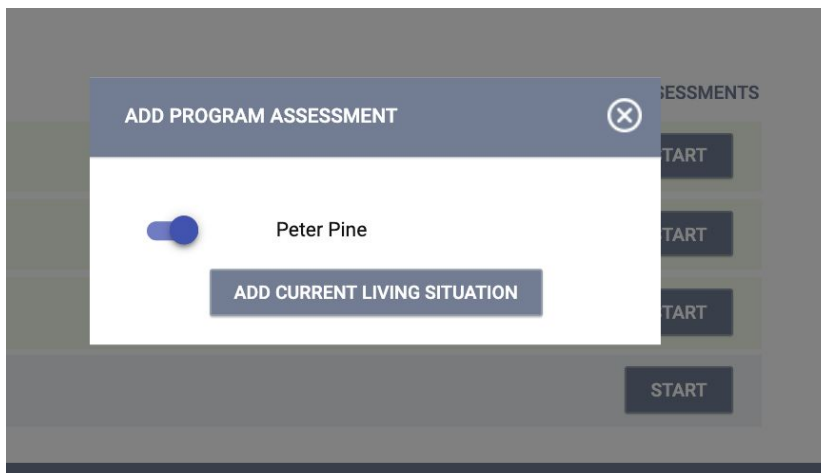

**Step 2:** Click on the Assessments Tab and click START on the Current Living Situation Assessment.


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**Step 3:** “Add Current Living Situation Assessment”
