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SF Family Eligibility Assessment

Procedures

<u>Step 1:</u> The Coordinated Entry Access Point staff or shelter staff will first discuss relocation assistance as an initial resolution.

<u>Step 2:</u> If relocation assistance is not a viable option for the household, the Coordinated Entry Family Access Point will complete the following in the ONE System:

- a. Profile
- b. Family Eligibility Assessment
- Program Enrollment
- d. Family Housing Primary Assessment

--->The "SF Family Eligibility Assessment" reflects changes made to HSH Policy and will replace the "Family Eligibility Assessment" on December 10th

- --->This assessment will determine if the family is eligible for services
- --->Should be completed before family members (beyond HoH) are added to ONE and family is enrolled a Family Coordinated Entry program
- --->Accessed though the Assessments tab on a client's profile while under the SF Family Coordinated Entry Agency



SF Family Eligibility Assessment

- ---> Once all the Eligibility Assessment questions are answered by the HoH, an "Eligibility Assessment Results" will be generated.
- → If the family is determined to be an "SF Homeless Family", the family (HoH and all family members) should then be enrolled in a Family Coordinated Entry Program.

Enrolling Families in Family Access Point Programs

--->If a family is eligible, enroll the HoH and all family members in a Family Access Point program as a group enrollment

--->The SF Family Shelter Assessment and Family Housing Primary Assessment will only be available under Family Access Point Programs (this is why the program enrollment must happen first)





Accessing Assessments in a Program Enrollment



--->Assessments (other than the SF Eligibility Assessment) are located under the Assessments tab within a client's Family Access Point program enrollment

--->Assessments should be completed under the HoH's enrollment

--->You can start new assessments here or view the client's assessment history within the program

--->Your active agency must be SFFCE to be able to see Family CE assessments



--->Will replace the Shelter (Individual Room) Placement Criteria assessment

--->Determines a family's position on the Temporary Shelter Queue based on the score they receive

• Assessment Date will be used to break scoring ties

--->Once you save the assessment a score will be generated and you can refer the client to the Temporary Housing Queue

--->Toggle the Temporary Shelter Queue on and click on Refer Directly to Community Queue



- --->Complete the referral by entering the referral date, any note you want to add and click *Send Referral*
- --->Confirm that a referral to the Temporary Shelter Queue has been completed by checking that: --->Referral appears under the
 - client's picture on their profile
 - --->Referral appears in the client's history

- ---> *SF Family Individual Shelter Room Placement Criteria Dashboard* will be retired and replaced by the *Families on the Temporary Shelter Queue dashboard.
- --->Access to this new dashboard is through the Data Analysis Tab under "Family CES"

---->Gives details of the family's household composition, if they have any active DoS's at family shelters and if they are enrolled in a housing program

--->If a family has an active housing program with a move in <u>date</u>, they should be removed from the Temporary Shelter Queue

--->Families seeking shelter while in RRH/Flex Pool housing search will not have a move in date and can remain on the Temporary Shelter Queue
